Great for institutional or commercial use in schools, hospitals, hotels, nursing homes, restaurants, athletic facilities, etc.

SPREADING RATE

- > Up to 11 square meters per litre depending on the moisture and porosity of the surface being painted.
- > Apply 2 coats.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO ENSURE THAT THIS TOTAL FILM THICKNESS IS ACHIEVED - DO NOT OVERSPREAD.

DRYING TIME

- > Dries in 2 hours. Apply the second coat 2 hours or longer after the first.
- Scrape-resistance over glossy surfaces develops in 5 to 7 days after Britannia Anti-Mould Acrylic Paint cures.
- If used above tile on shower walls, wait at least 24 hours before using shower.
- > Do not scrub the new coating for seven days.

SHELF LIFE

- > Up to 12 months if stored correctly in an unopened container.
- > Store within the temperature range 5°C 25°C
- > PROTECT FROM FROST

PREPARATION

- > All surfaces to be painted should be clean, dry and free from loose and flaking material.
- > Rub down previously gloss painted surfaces with fine waterproof abrasive paper and rinse thoroughly.
- > Avoid the inhalation of dust.
- > Wear a suitable face mask if dry sanding.
- > Treat any mould or lichen with Britannia's Fungicidal Wash Solution before removing with a scraper or stiff brush, then treat again.

APPLICATION

- > STIR WELL BEFORE USE.
- > Ensure maximum ventilation during application and drying.
- > Do not breathe spray, wear respiratory protection.
- > Seal absorbent surface with a first coat thinned down with up to 10% clean water.

LIMITATIONS

- > Anti-Mould Acrylic Paint is not intended for application to floors or any surface subject to water immersion or prolonged contact with water including shower enclosures, saunas or steam rooms.
- > Not recommended for use in HVAC duct work.

CLEANING

- > Remove as much product as possible from application equipment before cleaning.
- > Replace lid firmly.
- > Clean equipment immediately after use with warm soapy water and rinse thoroughly.

PRECAUTIONS

- > Keep out of reach of children.
- > In case of contact with eyes wash immediately with plenty of water.
- > Remove splashes from skin with soap and water or a recognised hand cleaner.
- > Protect from freezing.
- > Do not apply when the air or substrate temperatures are likely to fall below 10°C.
- > Do not use near fishponds.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- > Please refer to the Safety, Health and Environmental Information on the container.
- > Take special precautions during the surface preparation of pre 1960's painted surfaces as they may contain harmful lead.

- > When preparing the surfaces avoid the inhalation of dust and/or metal particles.
- > Wear a suitable facemask.
- > Store in secure dry conditions inaccessible to children or animals.
- > Containers should be kept closed during storage.
- > Do not empty into drains, watercourses or access routes to septic tanks.
- > Britannia Anti-Mould Acrylic Matt contains biocides to protect the dried film from fungal degradation. Once dried the paint film is classified as a treated article and contains the surface biocides 2-Octyl-4-isothiazolin-3-one and 2-methylisothiazol-3(2H)-one.
